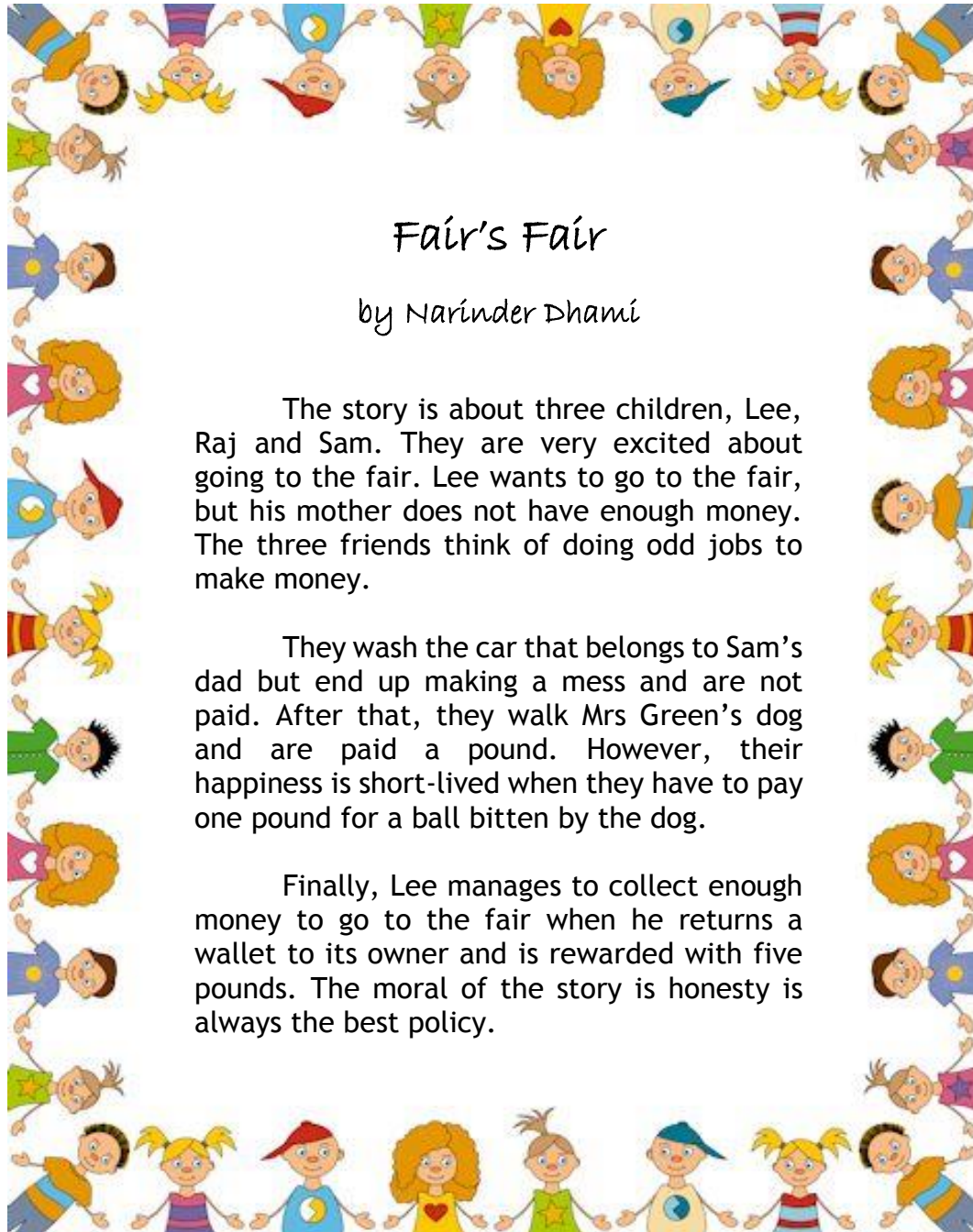


Synopsis
