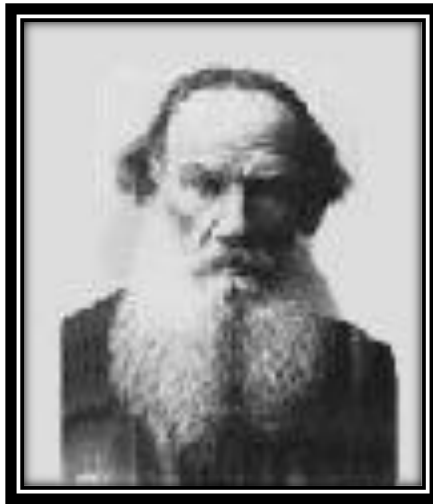

Johann David Wyss was born in 1743 and served as a clergyman in Bern, Switzerland. Wyss was very fluent in different languages. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and the outdoors. He was most remembered for his book, *The Swiss Family Robinson*, which was thought to be inspired by Daniel Defoe's shipwreck adventure, *Robinson Crusoe*. He passed away on 11 January 1818, at the age of 74.
